

# EMPLOYERS MUST POST OSHA FORM 300A

OSHA reminds employers that they must post a copy of OSHA's Form 300A, which summarizes job-related injuries and illnesses logged during 2021. Each year, between February 1 and April 30, the summary must be displayed in a common area where notices to employees are usually posted. Businesses with 10 or fewer employees and those in certain low-hazard industries are exempt from OSHA recordkeeping and posting requirements. # Illinois PHCC Legislative Update

The Spring Session of the Illinois General Assembly is quicky nearing the deadline for adjournment. Committees have been meeting virtually and House and Senate sessions are being held in-person, with mitigation requirements. With the primary election moved from March until June, the scheduled adjournment date for the General Assembly is April 8th rather than the traditional May 31st. Following are some of the bills we are watching and their current status.

### Plumbing/Piping/Trade Related Bills:

- HB 2538 (D. Stoneback) Creates the General Contractors Licensing Act; provides for the licensure of general contractors (including plumbing contractors and all other trades) by the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. Re-referred to House Rules.
- **HB 4245 (J. Hoffman)** Amends the Regulatory Sunset Act to extend the repeal date of provisions of the Illinois Plumbing License Law concerning irrigation contractors from January 1, 2024 to January 1, 2029. Passed the House and on 3rd Reading in the Senate.
- **HB 4295 (D. Stoneback)** In provisions regarding lead service line replacement, provides that as LSLs are replaced an owner or operator of a community water supply shall comply with specified provisions of the Illinois Plumbing Code regarding sewer crossings. Provides that when doing so will create an undue hardship due to excessive structural or mechanical difficulty, or impracticability, the owner or operator of the community water supply shall automatically be granted a variance by IDPH and be exempt from the separation requirements of the specified provisions. Assigned to the House Labor & Commerce Committee and later Re-referred to Rules
- HB 4482 (D. Conroy) Creates the Water Heater Safety Valve Act. Provides that a manufacturer or supplier of a hot water heater for use in a residential home or facility must supply or attach a temperature mixing valve or other safety valve to the hot water heater or tank that prevents water

temps above 120 degrees Fahrenheit from coming out of an outlet. Amends the Illinois Plumbing License Law to apply the same requirements to plumbers. Assigned to House Labor & Commerce Committee: Re-referred to Rules.

- HB 4810 (K. Wheeler) Amends the Fire Sprinkler Contractor Licensing Act to remove requirements for persons performing inspection or testing of any fire sprinkler system to possess proof of an appropriate level in level II & III NICET certification in Inspection and Testing. Assigned to House Labor & Commerce Committee; Re-referred to Rules.
- HB 5566 (L. Robinson, Jr.) Provides that the EPA shall provide grants to municipalities to provide filters for areas with lead service lines whose areas do not have a plan to replace the LSLs. Includes restrictions and specifications. Rereferred to House Rules.
- HB 5576 (C. Ammons) Provides that the State shall not regulate a profession, occupation, industry, business or trade in a manner that will unreasonably and adversely affect either the competitive market or equitable access to quality jobs and economic opportunities. Adds a requirement that the OMB's study on the performance of regulatory agencies shall include in its report whether the agency or program restricts a profession, occupation, business, industry or trade any more than is necessary to protect the public health, safety or welfare from significant and discernible harm or damage. Provides that the OMB's study can examine the termination, modification, or continuation of a regulatory agency or program. Passed the House and is on 3rd Reading in the Senate.
- SB 3014 (R. Villivalam) Amends the Swimming Facility Act to provide that seasonal events of religious institutions are exempt from rules adopted by IDPH requiring the installation of permanent structures. Referred to Senate Assignments.

SB 3741 (R. Villivalam) Provides that every municipality shall inspect all single-family residences and multi-family buildings in the municipality built before 1978 for the presence of lead paint and lead piping by June 1, 2024. Referred to Senate Assignments.

# Other Construction/Business Related Bills:

- HB 4268 (J. Mason) Provides that a duty of the regional superintendent of schools is to inspect the energy conservation measures of schools. Various issues regarding school energy conservation, guaranteed energy savings contract proposals, performance reviews, the award of a contract, and cost savings. Re-referred to House Rules.
- HB 4384 (E. Dina Delgato) Provides that within 30 days after the date that a written request for a change order is submitted by a contractor to a State agency, if the State agency fails to either issue the change order with an agreement on price or give specified written notice to the contractor, then the contractor may stop work. Provisions apply only to contracts for construction and construction-

- **HB 5088 (W. Davis)** Creates the Wage Theft Act. Re-referred to House Rules.
- HB 5412 (M. Evans) Amends the Illinois Wage
  Payment and Collection Act in relation to
  primary contractor responsibility for wage
  claims in the construction industry. Also applies
  to subcontractors of subcontractors. Amended
  and Passed in the House. Assigned to Senate
  Executive Committee.
- **SB 178 (L. Holmes)** This is an initiative of IMSCA which continues their work on retainage reform. Re-referred to Senate Assignments.

### IDOL Concludes Enforcement of Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act as Unemployment RATE FALLS BELOW FIVE PERCENT

State law mandates enforcement when jobless rate is above five percent.

Due to the improving economy in Illinois and the statewide unemployment rate falling to 5%, the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act is no longer in effect as of March 14th. The law, which requires employees on all public works projects to be comprised of a minimum of 90% Illinois residents, took effect on July 1, 2020, when the jobless rate was above five percent for two consecutive months.

On March 14th, the U.S. Department of Labor announced the state's jobless rate was five percent, triggering the suspension of enforcement of the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act.

"Following two challenging years due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Illinois' economy is improving thanks to policies implemented by the Pritzker Administration," said Illinois Department of Labor Acting Director Jane Flanagan. "The Illinois Department of Labor will continue enforcing the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act to ensure public tax dollars are granted to local contractors and workers."

The Illinois Department of Labor (IDOL) administers the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act, which was enacted to alleviate unemployment in Illinois by ensuring that most workers on public works projects are residents of the state. PHCC

### **Reviewing the OSHA Top 10**

Safety violations can occur in any number of ways, but there are plenty of opportunities to help create safer work environments. One way is to become familiar with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Top 10 list, which accounts for the most frequently cited standards following inspections of businesses and worksites by federal OSHA. <sup>1</sup> This helpful list can be used as a guide to learning what common risks to watch out for, and accessing vital information to help avoid devastating — and costly — worker injuries or fatalities.

Each year, OSHA posts their Top 10 violations after the month of April to allow the prior fiscal year's inspection data to finalize. For the 2020 fiscal year, the Top 10 consisted of:

- 1. Fall Protection(C)
- 2. Hazard Communication
- 3. Respiratory Protection
- 4. Scaffolding(C)
- 5. Ladders(C)

- 6. Lockout/Tagout
- 7. Powered Industrial Trucks
- 8. Fall Protection Training Requirements(C)
- 9. Eye and Face Protection
- 10. Machinery and Machine Guarding

OSHA inspections across the nation are completed at both the state and federal levels. In 2021, over 60,000 OSHA inspections occurred, resulting in more than 89,000 violations. Knowing that these risks exist — and that there are plenty of resources to help mitigate them — what will you do for your business to avoid becoming a part of this statistic?

Consider your specific business and workplace. Depending on the type of work that is done there, one or more of these safety risks may be present. Have you read the applicable standards? Written safety programs and regular training are great ways to help engage your employees in safer work habits. Post clear signage with workplace safety reminders, and verify that all employees are using the proper equipment and attire for their jobs. 
